| Week 3 | – Finalize, Peer Critique, Refine, and Finalize again your presentation. |
| Week 4 | – Present Presentations to class for final critique before presenting at the DAC. |
| Week 5 | – Create Artist Inspired art Piece to be exhibited along side your presentation at the DAC. |
| Week 6 | – Finalize, critique, refine, and finish art piece, READY for exhibition. |
