<b>Selection &amp; Refine Edge Tool(s)</b>	Copies & Pastes Teacher's face from original background onto a new body.  Edges are choppy, unrefined & easily seen. Copies & Pastes & Refines all edges of Teacher's face with advanced ( <i>radius, contrast, smooth, etc...</i> ) refinements to the edge of the selection. <b>Hue/Saturation/ADJUSTMENTS</b>	No tweaking of original hues or saturations.  Images are chosen because of similar skin tones and saturations. Hue, Saturation, and Lighting of face match the body/object without being able to tell where the face ends and the body/object begins.
